Safe Bicycling in Fort Collins

Please be a good example of a respectful bicyclist and follow the rules of the road. Ride with lights at night. Stop at traffic lights and stop signs. Use hand signals and eye contact to communicate your turns to motorists. Ride on the right hand side of the road and when cycling on bike trails signal to pass pedestrians and other cyclists with your bike bell. Always wear a helmet. Enjoy the ride!

Bicycling Info & Tips

Bicycles are a sensible form of transportation in Fort Collins. Our City offers over 280 miles of bike lanes, and over 30 miles of bike trails. Bicycling on College Ave in downtown is legal, but recommended for experienced bicyclists only. Please walk your bicycles through Old Town Square and on sidewalks in the downtown area. 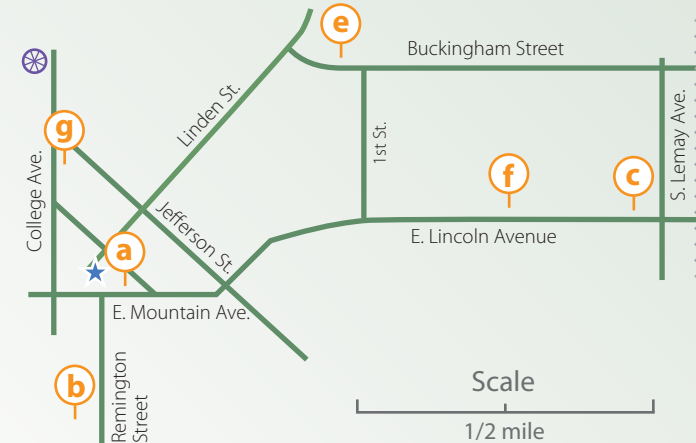

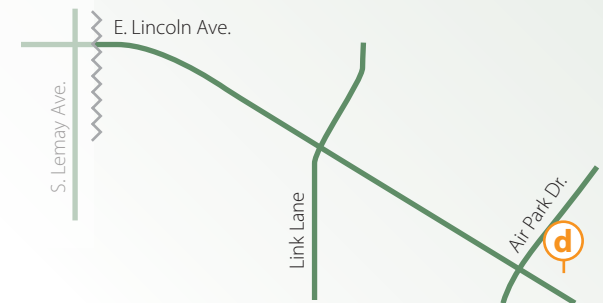
